Ngua (Nu-a): sun

Yerin (Yer-in): bush

Parnmin (Parn-min): rain

Djerang (Jer-rang): leaves

Wirrup (Wir-rip): trunk

Yeameneen beak

(Yer-men-een beak): earth

Baan (Barn): water

Yaluk (Yal-uk): creek

Boroin (Bor-oin): superb fairy-wren

Yanggai (Yang-guy): black cockatoo,

yellow tailed black cockatoo

Waa (Wah): raven

(sometimes called a crow)

Buath (Boo-ath): grass

Warin (Wa-ren): wombat

Garrang (Gar-rang): eucalypt

Wilam (Wil-um): home
